	3000 BCE	An active coastal trade linked the indus valley civilisations with presend-day west asia
	5th cnt.	Arab traders took pasta to sicily, an island now in italy.
	9th cnt.	Images of shps appear regularly in memorial stones found in the western coast, indicating the significance of oceaning trade.
	13th cnt.	Long distance spread of disease-carrying germs is clearly established
	15th cnt.	Silk routes existed that knitted together vast regions of Asia, and linked europe and northern Africa.
	16th cnt.	Europeaon sailors found a sea route to Asia and also successfully crossed the western ocean to America
	Mid-16th cnt.	Colonisation of america by european countries was under way.
	1730s	Coming up of the factories in England
18th cnt.		China and India were among the world's richest countries.
	1860s	Indian traders established flourishing emporia at busy parts worldwide, selling local and imported curios to tourists.
	1890s	A fast spreading disease of cattle plague or rinderpest had terrifying impact on people's livelihoods and the local economy.
19th cnt.		Economic, political, social, cultural and technological factors interacted in complex ways to transform soceities and reshape external relations.

	January 1914	Ford doubled the daily wage to \$5 to satisfy the factory workers
	1914	Outbreak of the first world war
	1920s	Mass production became a characteristic feature of indstrial production in growth of the US economy
	1921	Indentured labour system was abolised due to the opposition of indian nationalist leaders in the US.
	1923	The US resources exporting capital to the rest of the world and became the largest overseas lender
	1929	Beginning of the great depression
	1939	A modest economic recovery was under way in most industrial countries.
	1940s	Beginning of the second world war
	July 1944	United Nations monetary and financial conference held at bretton woods in new hampshire, USA
	1947	IMF and the World Bank commenced financial operations
	1949	Communist rule in China
